### INTRODUCTION

The library has lots of print and electronic resources relevant to engineering and the built environment. Print resources include the books, journals and theses that are shelved in the library. Electronic resources refer to the e-books and online journal databases that the library subscribes to - access these via the library website.

### PRINT RESOURCES

#### **BOOKS-DEWEY GUIDE**

Books are arranged according to a library classification system, known as the Dewey Decimal Classification System.

Books in the engineering and the building collections are shelved throughout the library.

- ◆ Students may borrow 7 books at any one time.
- ◆ Postgraduates may borrow 9 books at any one time.
- ◆ Staff may borrow 12 books at any one time.

Search for the titles required on the library catalogue and use your card to borrow them at the main desk.

### **JOURNALS**

Many of the journals in the library are useful for engineering and built environment students. There are lots of journals covering such topics as building, construction, electronics, mechanical and automobile engineering.

Current journals are on display in alphabetical order near the desk. Archived or back issues of journals are shelved in alphabetical order at the back of the library.

### **THESES**

There is a selection of engineering and built environment theses in the library. Titles are listed on the library catalogue. Theses are for library use only.

Simultaneously searches across multiple library databases. Searches books, journal articles, e-books and more! Provides a Google-like search experience using one search box to discover credible and reliable content.

## E-Book Central

Our e-books package contains thousands of e-books on all subjects including art and architecture, business and finance, computers and IT, engineering and technology, history, language and literature, law, health sciences, physical sciences, social sciences and more.
